Eligibility

The World Championship Mutton Bustin' World Finals event is open to all go-round winners from any of the 2009 WCMB Tour locations .

Rules and Regulations

- World Finals contestants must submit an entry form at www.muttonbustinnow.com by October 17, 2009 at midnight PST along with the \$10 registration fee in order to be entered in event.
- Riders must report in Fresno at the red Mutton Bustin' registration tent on October 18, 2009 before noon PST in order to complete onsite registration (weigh in, release waivers and paperwork review).
- Riders will be assigned a ride time during the day of October 18, 2009 at this time. Ride times are awarded on a first come, first served basis and will not be assigned prior to registrations on the 18th.

Riders, family and friends accompanying riders must travel to the World Finals event in Fresno, CA and must gain entrance into the Big Fresno Fair their own accord and at their sole expense. Riders must present an original or a certified copy of a birth certificate along with the receipt received when they submitted their registration in order for onsite registrations to be processed. A parent or legal guardian must complete a rider release waiver and all participants must weigh 60 lbs or less to compete. Children who qualified at the age of six but have turned seven since that fair are eligible to completed as long a their birth certificate validates this. There will be no exceptions made to the age or weigh requirement rules!

As with all World Championship Mutton Bustin' events, each participant will be required to wear a safety helmet and vest that Tommy G Productions will provide. Riders are allowed to use their own helmet, vest and chaps if they meet Tommy G Production's equipment standards. Riders will not be allowed to ride with ropes or spurs. Long sleeved shirts, jeans or pants and boots or tennis shoes are encouraged but not required.

World Finals participants will receive one (1) ride per qualifying heat. The top 35 entries will then be given one (1) opportunity to ride during the Finals round. The winner will be determined by the highest scored ride of that round or the longest timed ride, whichever applies. In the event of a tie, a ride off (each contestant will received a second sheep) will determine the winner. All judges' decisions are final.
